Consequences if Student Chooses to Fall Short of Expectations

First time	Non-verbal cue
Second time	Verbal Warning
Third time	Writing assignment determined by teacher
Fourth time	<i>or</i> flagrant violation: Parents/guardian notified, detention will be assigned
Fifth time	<i>or</i> flagrant violation: Parents/guardian notified, student referred to principal.
